Interchange Intro – 5th Edition (Cambridge University Press)

Unit 1: Alphabet recognition, greetings and introductions, personal information, titles and addresses, spelling names, phone numbers and email addresses.

Unit 2: Classroom vocabulary, personal objects, locations inside a room, articles (a, an, the), singular and plural nouns, prepositions of place and demonstratives.

Unit 3: Cities and countries, nationalities, physical appearance and personality adjectives, giving personal information and describing people.

Unit 4: Clothing vocabulary, colors, weather and seasons, possessive adjectives and pronouns, conjunctions (and, but, because) and descriptions of outfits.

Unit 5: Telling the time, parts of the day, daily activities, routines and present continuous for actions happening now.

Unit 6: Means of transportation, family relationships, weekly routines, days of the week, simple present and frequency expressions.

Unit 7: Types of houses and apartments, rooms and furniture, describing homes and using there is / there are.

Unit 8: Jobs and workplaces, describing work routines, giving opinions about professions and simple present questions.

Unit 9: Food and drinks, meals, healthy habits, count and noncount nouns, adverbs of frequency and expressing likes and dislikes.

Unit 10: Sports and free-time activities, abilities and talents, using can/can't for abilities and possibilities.

Unit 11: Months, dates, birthdays, holidays and celebrations, future plans with going to and invitations.

Unit 12: Body parts, health problems, medications, giving advice, imperatives and describing feelings and symptoms.

Unit 13: Stores, tourist attractions and places in the city, asking for and giving directions, prepositions of place and movement.

Unit 14: Weekend and vacation activities, summer activities, simple past with regular and irregular verbs and talking about past experiences.

Unit 15: Biographical information, dates and places of birth, school memories and past forms of the verb be.

Unit 16: Phone conversations, invitations, accepting and declining invitations, making arrangements and verb + to expressions.
